The Stewards heard evidence from the following persons:

verbal evidence from Christopher Mackenzie #21, Stuart Bliss #18, and Andrew Dyer #11. We saw the video footage of #21 (with and without sound), #18, and #63. The video footage from #11 was corrupted so could not be viewed. We also viewed circuit CCTV footage and read the post chief's report.

The Stewards decision is:

that the decision of the Clerk of the Course is upheld and the appeal fails.

Reason(s) for this decision:

On the evidence before the Stewards we found that it was more likely than not that car #21 made contact with the rear of car #18. Therefore, car #21 was predominantly responsible for causing the collision with car #18 at Paddock Hill Bend. The Stewards also find that the penalty imposed by the Clerk of the Course was appropriate.
