**Race Director Note #1 – Track Limits**



**Race Control Note regarding the monitoring of track limits for this event.**

**Q 12.21.2.** Drivers must use the track at all times and may not leave the track without a justifiable reason. For the avoidance of doubt:

- (a) The white lines defining the track edges are considered to be part of the track.
- (b) A driver will be judged to have left the track if any wheel of the car goes completely beyond either the outer edge of any kerb or the white line where there is no kerb.

The circuit operates automated cameras that will monitor track limits at Turns 1, 4, & 7. Competitors are reminded that the white line or the edge of the painted kerb behind the white line is the track limit. The judge of fact at T10 will report any car that runs beyond the edge of the painted kerb.
