Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

C1.1.5 Driving in a manner incompatible with general safety, and/or departing from the standard of a reasonably competent driver.

Brief Details:

The hearing was convened following Milltek Sport Civic Cup race 1, as a result of a heavy collision involving car 42 and a circuit barrier and marshal's post.

Following viewing of in car footage, it became clear that as a result of a collision at T 17 (dealt with separately), the cars steering became damaged, with the steering wheel about 80 degrees off centre.

As a result of the damaged steering, the driver of car 42 appeared to lose control exiting T 5, and made heavy contact with the barrier and marshals post between T 5 and T 6. There was a waving yellow flag at that post because of a car that had stopped at that post, with marshals in attendance, though it was agreed that the driver had had no chance to see the flag before losing control.

Nevertheless it was felt that attempting to continue the race with a damaged car constituted driving in a manner incompatible with general safety, and the driver was penalised with a ten place grid penalty, to be served at the first opportunity when that penalty can be taken.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Grid Place Penalty to be served at a future race, when that can be applied.

Number of Licence Penalty Points: 3

Additional Comments: A 10 place grid penalty, only to served when the full penalty may be served.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
