Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

C1.1.6 & Q12.24.3(m) Failure to comply with Black Flag signals.

Brief Details:

The driver of Car 97 (Melly Zhang) was given a Black Flag for inadequate control of their vehicle, having lost control of their car five times in successive laps. This decision was made on safety grounds both for the driver of Car 97 and others sharing the circuit.

A Black Flag was shown both by the Startling Marshal, as well as displayed on the Digital Flag Panel, however the driver of Car 97 did not return to the pit lane, having passed the Black Flag more than three times.

The driver was asked to see the Clerk of the Course after returning to the pit lane after the end of the race, and the driver was interviewed. The driver stated they had not seen the Black Flag signals on any occasion.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
