Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q12.21.4 Causing a collision

Brief Details:

Contact was reported at post 6 between car 11 and car 123 resulting in car 123 making contact with the barrier, causing a session stop.

During the restarted race, contact was reported between car 11 and car 53, resulting in car 53 spinning into the gravel.

Drivers of cars 11, 53 and 123 interviewed and onboard footage from cars 53 and 123 were reviewed, together with live stream footage. No footage was available from car 11.

Based on the evidence available, I deem both instances to be avoidable contact therefore the guideline penalty for contact applies.

Driver of car 11 verbally informed of decision at 14:42hrs.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Disqualified from the results of the race.
Number of Licence Penalty Points: 4

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
