### **Brief Details:**

I have reviewed a collision on lap one of the second Pre 99 Formula Ford race between car 28 and 68 at paddock hill bend. On reviewing the circuit footage and the in car video of car 68, Richard Freye I feel that the first corner contact between Mr Freye and car 28 Mr Hawkins lies with the driver of car 68. My decision is based on this evidence and interviewing both drivers involved.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Disqualified from the results of the race.
