Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q12.21.4 Causing a collision

Brief Details:

Contact made rounding first part of Rocket, with car 27 on inside. Whilst cornering, the rear of car 27 slid in to the side of car 23, causing 23 to run wide. It was noted that car 27 made the apex of the turn as would be expected. Both onboards viewed and both drivers interviewed.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

No Further Action - Having investigated the incident referred to above, and reviewed all available footage, I find that there is insufficient evidence of driving in a matter incompatible with general safety and consider the matter to be a racing incident, and therefore I will take no further action.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
