C3.3 You will have all practice times disallowed. I will permit you to start the race(s) from the back of the grid with a 10 second delayed start, providing that you are not taking the place of any vehicle already qualified (whether a reserve or not). If the race is a rolling start, you will start from the pit lane after all other cars have started. (See Q 12.9.4 for further details).

Additional Comments: Permission to start the race granted subject to the Vehicle being represented to the Chief Scrutineer for full Safety Scrutineering prior to the race.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
