Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

C1.1.3 Any dishonest act or proceeding in connection with an event and/or motor sport generally.

### **Brief Details:**

Having received a report from the Chief Scrutineer (with photo evidence) and having given the competitor an opportunity to be heard, it is clear from the evidence to hand that the Fire Extinguishers Manufactures Label has been tampered with in order to falsify an extended service expiry date.

The competitor was interviewed and accepted that the Fire Extinguisher has been tampered with by a team member (unknowingly to the competitor), but that as the entrant driver he is responsible for those actions.

Present in the Hearing was Sid Smith (the Competitor), Rob Smith (Parent), Jamie Going (representative), Luke Souch (Clerk of the Course), Darren Holmes (Deputy Clerk of the Course), and Laura Payne (Observer).

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Additional Comments: The vehicle has been impounded since the end of the Qualifying Session and the Chief Scrutineers report. The Chief Scrutineer is now directed to remove the Extinguisher from the vehicle and seal it with a Motorsport UK seal. The competitor must represent the vehicle for full Safety Scrutineering prior to any future permitted track activity.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
