Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

**Brief Details:**

Car 68 (A Bywaters) span on exit of T3 Palmers and came to rest drivers left of circuit, initially covered by yellow flags while marshals in attendance and later by hazard board.

Four (4) minutes later, from race log, car 959 (M Head) span at same location and continued. A further two (2) minutes later (next lap) 959 (M Head) spins again at same location and makes contact with car 68.

Penalized 5 places on next race entered plus 3 License points ref repetition of mistakes

**Evidence Relied Upon:**

Interviewed driver M Head in presence of spouse (A Head) as support to M Head.

Track log (GTApps) was referred to and shown
