Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

C2.3 Gaining an unfair advantage (whether inadvertently or not)

### **Brief Details:**

Report received of contact between car 40 and 87 at turn 3. Footage viewed from both cars and driver of car 40 interviewed. Driver of car 40 admitted he was at fault, he was attempting an overtake on the inside of car 87 and was partly alongside but locked up under braking and slid into the side of car 87, forcing car 87 wide and car gained the position.

I find car 40 at fault and will give a time penalty to place car 40 behind car 87 in the race results, but educated the driver on how he should have given the place back to car 87 in race and should consider this for future.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Addition of time to your race time.

Additional Comments: Addition of 1 second to your race time.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
