During a pit stop car 44 was raised on jacks, a mechanic carried out work on the car, another operative released the jacks, the car dropped with the mechanic still working on the car. Pit manager reported the incident, team manager Callum George was interviewed by the race director and admitted the incident had taken place. Race director expressed concern about the lack of safety, the team is fined £300.
