Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

C3.3 Eligibility - Post Practice Scrutineering: Following a receipt of a report from a Scrutineer / Eligibility Scrutineer / Technical Commissioner and having given you the opportunity to be heard, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following regulations: (Scrutineers Report attached)

Brief Details:

Report received from Scrutineer that in post qualifying scrutineering car 35 weighed 1142Kgs, which contravenes championship regulation 5.14.2 which states the minimum weight should be 1160Kgs. Driver informed.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

C3.3 You will have all practice times disallowed. I will permit you to start the race(s) from the back of the grid with a 10 second delayed start, providing that you are not taking the place of any vehicle already qualified (whether a reserve or not). If the race is a rolling start, you will start from the pit lane after all other cars have started. (See Q 12.9.4 for further details).

Additional Comments: 10 second delayed start not applied as scrutineers report received too late to action before Race 1. Car 35 qualified at the back of the grid anyway so was in the appropriate grid position as per the penalty.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
