Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

On lap 2 car 27 attempted to pass 47 into Turn 1 on drivers right.
Front left of car 27 contacted the rear right of car 47, with 47 then spinning into gravel, retiring.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Onboard footage of cars 27 and 47 reviewed.
Drivers of 27 and 47 interviewed.

Accordingly, under NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Grid Place Penalty to be served at a future race, when that can be applied.
Number of Licence Penalty Points: 3

Additional Comments: 5 place grid penalty.
