A Right of Review hearing was held at 1115 on Saturday 21 September at Thruxton circuit, following receipt of the Right of Review application. The Right of Review relates to an incident in the third TCR UK race held at Silverstone on 18 August 2024, following which the driver of car 17 was given a Formal Reprimand with 2 licence penalty points.

Present: Andrew Holley (TCR UK Clerk of Course); Brad Hutchison (competitor); Martin Hutchison (entrant and appellant); Jack Finlan (TCR UK championship coordinator).

Following the submission of the application, which included three photographs, the Clerk agreed that the photographs showed the incident in a different light, and the Clerk conceded that the photos were both significant and relevant.

The Clerk decided that the original decision of a Formal Reprimand for Causing a Collision was therefore unsafe, and felt that the incident should be deemed a Racing Incident instead.

Therefore the competitor (B Hutchison) should have the penalty and the penalty points removed, and the Right of Review fee should be returned to the entrant (M Hutchison).

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
