Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.12 Art.3.1 Failure to wear properly fastened and positioned Personal Safety Equipment.

Brief Details:

On the slow down lap following the end of the race car 46 was shouting abusive language at the driver of car 16 from within his own car whilst travelling around the circuit. Car 46 then proceeded to take off his seat belt/harness whilst entering the pit lane. Car 46 then continued with abusive language in parc ferme as reported by the championship coordinator.

The on-board footage from car 46 was reviewed. The driver of car 46 was interviewed and remorseful about his language and behaviour but expressed his frustration over driving standards during the race. He has apologized to the championship coordinator for his outburst.

Driver of car 46 was fined £250 and 3 penalty points on his license.
