Amendment to decision 4.

Report received from Scrutineer following post-race Scrutineering after Race 1. Car 11 was found to be in contravention of Championship Regulation 5.7.1.6 as 'Camshaft timing not set to manufacturers standard specification'.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

C3.5.1 (a) + (b) - The event will still count as one of the events contributing to your total Championship score, and you will be disqualified from the event (race) forfeiting all Championship points, prize money and other awards.

Additional Comments: This decision has been re-issued due to a clerical error in earlier decision which referred to wrong race.
