The Stewards, having received a Technical protest from Hitech GP against car \#7 from Douglas Motorsport, the Stewards summoned and heard from the Wayne Douglas of Douglas Motorsport, Phil Blow of Hitech and Alister Poulter, Eligibility Scrutineer and, having considered the following matter, determine the following:
Car \#11
Competitor: Douglas Motorspport
Time (fact): $\quad 12: 25 \mathrm{hrs}$
Session: Qualifying
Fact: Using a wrapping material to cover halo fixing holes
Offence: $\quad$ Breach of Article 4.4.3 of the 2023 GB3 Championship Partnered by the BRDC Sporting Regulations (the Regulations)
Decision: Protest Upheld and Cancelation of all Qualifying laps for Car \#11
Reason: Mr Douglas asserted that the Protest lodged by Hitech had been brought in 'bad faith'. The Stewards have carefully considered but rejected this assertion. The Stewards note that Article 4.4.3 of the Regulations allows for some components to be wrapped with a suitable material for their protection from heat damage, abrasion damage or ballistic damage. Mr Douglas advised the Stewards that the wrapping was primarily for purpose of preventing water ingress to the halo retaining bolt holes. The Stewards are satisfied that a breach of Article 4.4.3 has occurred and impose the penalty cited above. Appeal Fee Returned

In accordance with Article 12.3.3.b of the Code and Article 3.4 of the Regulations, this decision is not susceptible to Appeal and, according, there is no suspensive effect.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
