Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

C1.1.9 Abusive language or behaviour, physical assault, or threats of physical assault within the area under the control of the Organising Club.

Brief Details:

Driver interviewd with Mr Boston (driver rep) present and Charles Gratton (Asst Clerk).

At 730pm last night, after been given a verbal judicial decision by Andrew Roberts (Clerk for Mazda MX5s) the driver shouted at the clerk "Fuck off" before then leaving the room and shouting "fuck off stupid cunt". The driver then proceeded to exit the race control corridor slamming doors, damaging the final door and wall in the process.

Written statements from witnesses Andrew Roberts (Clerk) Andy Holley (Clerk) and Tony Apsion (Safety Car Obs) who all witnessed this incident.

Callum returned to race control shortly after the incident and apologised to the clerk.

Callum admitted the incident as decribed and understood that his behaviour was uacceptable. A race with respect referral has been completed and as a result of the drivers actions I disqualify him from the meeting.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Disqualified from the meeting.
