C1.1.6 & Q12.24.3 (n) Contravention of flag and/or Light Signal - Black and White Chequered flag: End of Race or Practice.

### **Brief Details:**

The chequered flag was displayed at the end of the warm up session. car #3 was the fourth car to pass the chequered flag approximately 40seconds after it was displayed. Car #3 was reported to pass the chequered flag for a second time.  
In car video evidence from car #3 was reviewed, time keepers confirmed.
