### **Brief Details:**

Car 29 lost control and ran wide of the circuit at vale in (turn 8), when car 29 returned to the circuit, car 6 wasn't aware, this is not to say car 29 made a unsafe re-join, but because of the close proximity, car 29 made light contact with car 6, both car spun and car 29 retired. Driver of Car 29 understand that they need to be more aware when re-joining
