### **Brief Details:**

Photographic evidence seen of Car 32 been worked on in the pitlane with the car on jacks and team members at the front left wheel. Present were Luke Hilton (Driver) Dan Hilton (Parent) Liam Hamilton (Team) Bobby Thompson (Coach) Rob Sims (Team) Chalres Gratton (Asst Clerk) Laura Payne.

Team disputed that the qualifying parc ferme was valid as there was only reference to practice and race in the regualtions.

Decision that the car was worked on during parc ferme conditions - disqualified from results of qualifying.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Disqualified from the results of qualifying or practice.
