Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

## **Brief Details:**

Marshal reports and live stream footage evidence showed contact between Car 16 and Car 100 at Turn 8 on Lap 3. Car 100 ran wide and continued, Car 16 continued.  
Further marshal reports and live stream footage evidence showed contact between Car and Car 101 at Turn 11 on Lap 3. Car 101 spun and continued, Car 16 continued. Drivers of Cars 16, 100 & 101 interviewed. Onboard footage reviewed from Car 16, 100 & 101.

## **Evidence Relied Upon:**

Onboard footage from Cars 16, 100 & 101.

Accordingly, under NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Addition of time to your race time.

Additional Comments: Car 16 issued with a time penalty of 24 seconds to their race time. NCR 12.10.2.1(I)

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with the NCR.
