Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.2 App.1 Art.1.13 Driving in a manner not compatible with general safety

**Brief Details:**

Driver of car 20 was reported as overtaking at Turn 1 between yellow signals and an incident, on consecutive laps, with marshals trackside.

Driver of car 20 interviewed and onboard footage reviewed from cars 23 and 58 which confirmed the reports, including the location of the yellow signals and the marshals. I deem this to be driving in a manner incompatible with general safety, therefore apply the guideline penalty and refer the matter to the stewards for further consideration.
