Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q12.21.4 Causing a collision

### **Brief Details:**

Report received of contact between car 5 and car 40 approaching Turn 3, however on review of video evidence it was established that contact was actually between car 5 and car 51 at Turn 2. On board video evidence was viewed from car 5 and car 51 and also car 47 who was following a couple of cars behind. Drivers of cars 5 and 51 were interviewed.

I find car 5 predominantly at fault for the collision as contact was made with the side of car 51 just behind the drivers door, so was not far enough alongside at the apex of Turn 2. Car 51 had gone off circuit and rejoined below race speed just before turn 1, however the collision at Turn 2 was investigated on its own merit as both cars were at similar race speed by time they exited turn 1.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Grid Place Penalty to be served at a future race, when that can be applied.  
Number of Licence Penalty Points: 3

Additional Comments: 5 place grid penalty to be applied at a future race.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
