Hearing conducted at Croft Circuit, 14/07/2024, into possible offence of driving in a manner incompatible with general safety (C1.1.5) at turn 4. Car 64 ran wide at Turn 4 and took to the longer international circuit to rejoin, car 64 was alleged by Post Chief and recovery attendants to have driven at speed, and out of control, dangerously approaching the Island point of rejoin where recovery units were stationed.

On interview with driver of car 64 and their entrant regarding the incident the driver stated he was not aware of the vehicles stationed at the rejoin point and believed he did the safest thing to not u-tun back to oncoming vehicles at Island, which I agreed with. On review of video footage of car 64, the video shows car 64 running wide and taking to the international circuit, he does come to the rejoin point at what may be considered fast but the driver did scrub speed off and took to the grass as there was a recovery unit operative in the track. At all times the driver had full control of his car, and rejoined via the Brittens chicane safely.

Clerk of the Course believes whilst appearing to be slightly fast approaching the rejoin point, the driver was in full control of the car and took to grass as track was blocked by a person waving him down.

Decision: No further action.
