Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

C2.3 Gaining an unfair advantage (whether inadvertently or not)

### **Brief Details:**

At turn 5 car 77 overtook car 88 while exceeding track limits, car 77 did not give the place back. Driver of car 77 was interviewed and footage viewed from car 77 and the live stream. Car 77 to be given a position penalty to place the driver behind car 88 in the results of the race.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Position Penalty to be applied to this race result.

Additional Comments: Driver of car 77 to be given a 2 place position penalty for the results of this race.

Version 2 - In accordance with NCR C.2.13 this decision sheet is reissued to correct a clerical error, that being that the infringement took place at turn 5, not turn 3. The penalty is unchanged.

### C.2.13. Correction of Clerical Errors.
