Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q12.21.4 Causing a collision

### **Brief Details:**

Car 14 made contact with Car 46 at the hairpin exit, causing Car 46 to lose position. After reviewing onboard footage from both cars and the live stream, it is evident that Car 46 was slow out of the hairpin. Car 14 then made slight contact with the rear driver's left side of Car 46, causing Car 46 to run wide and lose a position. The contact was minimal, and the track conditions were wet

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
