Eligibility scrutineer report received that car 39 commenced the qualifying session with 1x tyre in contravention of championship regulation 5.13.1.

Driver came in during the session to change said tyre. Driver interviewed and verbally informed of decision at 10:34hrs.

Accordingly, under NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

NCR Ch.2 App.8 Arts.1.20-1.21 - You will have all practice times disallowed. I will permit you to start the race(s) from the back of the grid with a 10 second delayed start, providing that you are not taking the place of any vehicle already qualified (whether a reserve or not). If the race is a rolling start, you will start from the pit lane after all other cars have started.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with the NCR.
