Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Brief Details:

Cars 18, 62 & 96 were involved in an incident at turn 6 resulting in car 96 being stuck in the gravel.
Following review of circuit footage, onboard footage of car 62 and interviewing all three drivers it was found to be a racing incident.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

No Further Action - Having investigated the incident referred to above, and reviewed all available footage, I find that there is insufficient evidence of driving in a matter incompatible with general safety and consider the matter to be a racing incident, and therefore I will take no further action.
