Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q12.21.4 Causing a collision

Brief Details:

Contact between cars 16 and 76 exiting T6, causing car 16 to spin off the circuit and subsequently stop at the pits. Mitigating circumstances were that both cars had run through T4-T6 side by side and that car 16 was right on the edge of the circuit, but it was felt that driver of 76 could have given room to car 16 to prevent the contact.
Evidence taken from in car footage from both cars, and live TV footage.
