### **Brief Details:**

Contact between 26 and 21 at exit of Turn 12, with car 21 forced off circuit.  
21 had given racing room for 26 at apex of Turn 12, but 26 did not give racing room at exit, contact occurred and 21 left circuit.  
Evidence taken from on board footage of both cars 26 and 21, and an interview with driver of car 26 with parent/guardian.
