Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

Front to rear contact, 144 to 14 at Turn 4 (Brooklands) on the last lap, causing car 144 to gain a position. Viewed footage from both cars and interviewed both drivers. There was contact, enough to sent 14 wide between Brooklands and Luffield. 144 passed 14 at this time. He was first to take the flag at the end of that lap.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Video evidence from both cars, interviews with both drivers. The responsible person for Mr Foxlow was present as he is under 18.

Accordingly, under NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Position Penalty to be applied to this race result.
Number of Licence Penalty Points: 3

Additional Comments: Position penalty of 1 position - this puts the positions to where they were before the contact.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with the NCR.
