Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q12.21.1 Manoeuvres liable to hinder other drivers, such as deliberate crowding of a car beyond the edge of the track or any other abnormal change of direction.

### **Brief Details:**

Car 77 had pulled alongside Car 21 between T12 & T1 with Car 77 on track left. Car 21 made a change of direction to his left forcing Car 77 off the circuit. Car 77 struck bollards marking the track edge at the pit exit damaging his wing and puncturing his left front tyre. Car 77 went into the gravel at T1 and retired. Car 21 continued to finish the race.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Disqualified from the results of the race.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. The penalty applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
