Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q12.21.4 Causing a collision

Brief Details:

Driver of car 75 reported to the Clerk of the Course that they had contact from another car at Turn 7 on Lap 1. Onboard footage from car 75 showed car 47 to be the other car involved. Onboard footage from car 47 was then viewed and driver interviewed.

I find car 47 at fault for the contact with car 75. Car 47 accepted they were at fault for the contact. Mitigating circumstances were considered of car 47 locking brakes under braking.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
