### **Brief Details:**

Report of contact between cars 174 and 777 at Turn 3 on lap 2. Both drivers interviewed and front facing onboard footage viewed from car 777.

Car 777 comes from a long way back and makes significant contact with rear right corner of car 174 causing car 174 to spin.
