Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.9 Slow, erratic or potentially dangerous driving.

**Brief Details:**

With car 47 in the gravel at Turn 1, the incident had been covered by yellow signals whilst marshals attended. Once the marshals and driver were clear, the yellow signals were withdrawn and replaced with a hazard board. Shortly after, car 777 lost control at the apex of Turn 1 and spun into the gravel near car 47, under hazard board conditions.

Driver was very apologetic and admitted it was a misjudgement.

Marshals were not trackside and the track conditions were wet. I take these as mitigating factors, nevertheless a penalty is warranted. Driver verbally informed of decision at 12:43hrs.
