Brief Details:

Technical protest received at 16:25 from Joel Wren (Car 741) stating that car 746 (Oliver Birkett) was in breach of TR5.19.6.1 of the Mini7 Championship Regulations (Technical).

Checks were carried out by Julian Affleck (Eligibility Scrutineer) and in the presence of the Chief Scrutineer (Paul Hewer).

Julian Affleck submitted a report number #007 which stated he does not agree on technical grounds that the regulation is not compliant.

As a result the protest fails and the fee is forfeited.
