During the race there was a collision involving Car 66 (Chloe Grant) and Car 21 Alisha Palmowski. As a result Car 66 spun into the gravel and did not restart. Car 21 continued. Both drivers were summoned to the Clerk of the Course and attended with their Team Managers and Guardian (Car 66). Grant was of the opinion that Palmowski bore responsibility for the collision while Palmowski disagreed feeling that it was a racing incident, On board video was shown to all parties from Car 21. In the opinion of the Driving Standards Advisor (Rob Barff) and the Clerk of Course both drivers could have taken action to avoid the collision and that neither party was wholly or predominantly to blame for the incident. The incident is 'noted' and no further action is proposed.
