Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q12.21.4 Causing a collision

Brief Details:

Car 2 had passed 2 cars in the gravel at T1 whilst yellow flags were showing at T1. The following lap Car 2 approached T1 and lost control of his car after passing a yellow flag displayed at T1. The car ended up making contact with car 31 that was beached in the gravel and came to rest against the tyre wall. Marshalls were present at the scene. The driver has been spoken to, in car video from car 2 has been reviewed.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Disqualified from the meeting.

Additional Comments: The driver was regretful of the incident and did question the clerk of the courses decision about not running full course yellow at this moment.
