Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q12.21.1 Manoeuvres liable to hinder other drivers, such as deliberate crowding of a car beyond the edge of the track or any other abnormal change of direction.

Brief Details:

Start line incident to first corner. 88 started to the left off the start with 46 making a good start. a gap was present between 99 and 46 which 52, making an excellent start saw a gap and started going through. 46 saw 88 trying to pass on the left hand side and closed the door ensuring 88 had to keep to the grass. With 46 attention diverted 52 went through the gap however at that point 46 started to take the natural line to the corner and started moving right. 52 by this point was alongside and 46 therefore made side to side contact with 52 leading to contact with 99.

99 backed out at this point and 46 went back to the left of the circuit with 52 continuing his pass up the right of the track. 52 then started to turn in across 46 and with 46's momentum was turned around and ultimately into the barrier on the left hand side of the corner by post 2.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

No further action. All 4 cars involved were unable to change their line at the time of the incident.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. The penalty applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
