Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

Contact side to side between car 99 and car 14 at Turn 16, with both cars spinning.
On the incident and prior lap it was evident car 14 was slower than 99, and in opinion of clerk of course the driver of 99 did not take this into consideration on the lap contact occurred. Car 99 appeared to be closer on incident lap than prior, but made the move too far back.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Onboard footage of car 99.
Interview with drivers of car 99 and 14.
Data traces from car 14 (as no video footage available).*
Hayfisher TV footage.
* Data was viewed from 99 but was difficult to interpret, and therefore not used as evidence.

Accordingly, under NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Grid Place Penalty to be served at a future race, when that can be applied.
Number of Licence Penalty Points: 3

Additional Comments: 5 place grid penalty.
