Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

**Brief Details:**

Contact reported between cars 4 and 88 at Turn 1. Onboard footage from both cars and live stream reviewed and both drivers interviewed.

Footage and interviews confirmed that contact occurred as the cars approached the apex of Turn 1. Visibility of Turn 1 was reduced due to sun and spray and footage did show car 4 had braked before car 88 had come into view. Car 88 also appeared to have a broken left hand mirror. I take these as mitigating factors not to give the guideline penalty, however I believe the contact was avoidable and a penalty is warranted for driver of car 4.
