Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

## **Brief Details:**

Marshal report received of contact between car 174 and 26 at Turn 3. Footage viewed from both cars front facing onboard footage and drivers interviewed. During viewing of onboard footage, a further contact incident involving the front of car 26 into the rear of car 174 on the lap previous at the same corner is also viewed.

I find the contact that was originally reported to be a racing incident. The contact on the previous lap I find car 26 at fault as they came from too far back approaching the corner and made contact with the rear of car 174, causing them to half spin and car 174 is not at fault.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

No Further Action - Having investigated the incident referred to above, and reviewed all available footage, I find that there is insufficient evidence of driving in a matter incompatible with general safety and consider the matter to be a racing incident, and therefore I will take no further action.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
