Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q12.21.4 Causing a collision

Brief Details:

Car 171 was behind and to the left of Car 191 as they both entered Surtees corner (a left hander to start with). As Car 191 started turning left 171 stayed in position leading to contact between Car 171 front right wheel and Car 191 rear left wheel, causing both to exit the circuit to the left contacting the barrier.

Video footage observed from circuit footage and live tv footage. Interview with Car 171

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Additional Comments: Car 191 turned in believing that Car 171 was already behind. Car 191 believed Car 171 was going to turn in later. Racing incident. Reminded Car 171 of racing line observance may lead to contact. Neither car finished the race.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. The penalty applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
