If you overtake under a yellow flag, expect ACTION




RED Flag

When the red flag is deployed all cars shall immediately reduce speed to 80km/h.











Speed Controlled by Radar and GPS











Fast Lane

Driving Standards:

When leaving the pit lane/out lap

Do not weave across the track

RESPECT CARS ON A HOT LAP

Driving Standards:

Drivers in both classes must take care whilst overtaking during all sessions.

GT3 and GT4 cars are clearly identified:

GT4 have BLACK windscreen banners and yellow headlights

GT3 have WHITE windscreen banners

Rear ID in both classes GT3 and GT4 stickers


Yellow Flag infringements


Track Limits:

WARNINGS WILL BE ISSUED ON TIMING SCREEN and /or RADIO Turn 1, Turn 4, Turn 7 using track side sensors. T10 using dedicated CCTV, will be monitored for safety – tyre stack in place for all BGT sessions.

FP; persistent offenders- black flag (stop/go) Both drivers report to race control

PQ; Lap times will be deleted – also as above

QUALIFYING; Lap times will be deleted



Race penalty menu:

Track limit infringements in <u>2hr race</u> = 3 x TSL Screen warnings,

4th infringement is B/W flag,

5th is a drive through penalty,







RACE START

- Green flag from the start line
- All cars maintain running order
- Cars stop weaving at T10
- Lead car (safety car) extinguish lights
- Cars 2 x 2 between T11 and T12
- Lead car will pull to PIT LANE




Missing car? **DO NOT** close the gap

RACE START GT4 GAP WILL BE 2 ROWS MINIMUM






Cars in two lines driving over the grid boxes Start Lights Red: when turned OFF= START OF RACE GT3 AND GT4



OUT OF POSITION START:






FULL COURSE YELLOW - FCY

- Radio message "prepare full course yellow in 20s"
- At 10s- waved flags / yellow signals displayed
- no overtaking
- DO NOT STAMP ON YOUR BRAKES!!
- PREPARE TO SLOW TO 80
- At ZERO s, FCY displayed on light panels = 80KPH
- all cars at 80KPH







Short Full Course Yellow – 2 hour race

- If incident expected to be cleared quickly
- Radio message "restart on short notice"
- Countdown will follow ..5,4,3,2,1
- Light panels will change to GREEN after count down
- Racing recommences






Long Full Course Yellow – 2 hour race

- If incident expected to involve recovery activity
- Radio message "long full course yellow"
- If FCY occurs during pit window, FCY will remain until all cars have completed pit stops
- When race control ready, SC will join the track without lights
- SC will position itself in front of race leader
- Race control will declare "safety car procedure"
- SC will illuminate YELLOW lights
- All cars accelerate to join SC queue






- "SC procedure"
- All marshal posts will display SC boards and waved yellow flags....LIGHT PANELS "SC"
- All cars, in single file, must catch up the group when safe to do so
- End of procedure: "SC in this lap"
- "SC lights off" after T8 all signalling removed
- Safety car exits via PIT LANE
- No overtaking prior to pass the FINISH line

LATE RACE INCIDENTS



- Incidents that occur towards the end of race:
 - If visibility is good
 - Track not blocked
 - May be covered with yellow flags
 - TEAM MANAGERS will be informed
 - You must slow down, maintain full control
 - ABSOLUTELY NO TRACK LIMITS
 - No overtaking before green flag

• Respect flags.
