- Good race starts 2 x 2 formation
- PIT LANE DISCIPLINE ESSENTIAL many penalties
- Regulation breaches and BWP (3 x BWP = 5 place grid drop, 4 x BWP = 10 place grid drop)
- Speeding in pit lane
- Speeding under red flag conditions
- RESPECTING YELLOW FLAGS APPROACHING AN INCIDENT
- Causing a collision, expect minimum stop/go

No overtaking.






SPEED LIMIT PIT LANE

Speed Controlled by Radar and GPS



Testing and adjustments can be made Saturday in FP1, but by FP2 no more adjustments to the working areas once finally checked.


Please work with your neighbours. There are spare garages, they are spread along pit lane.






Fire Lane – line of sight required

GT3 and GT4 cars are clearly identified:

GT4 have BLACK windscreen banners and yellow headlights

GT3 have WHITE windscreen banners

Rear ID in both classes GT3 and GT4 stickers





Free Practice 1 & 2

3 warnings on timing screen, 4th infringement black and white flag, 5th infringement will result in a STOP GO – BOTH DRIVERS TO RACE CONTROL


FP2 & Qualifying

Lap time will be deleted

PENALTIES DO NOT RESET IN THIS RACE

3 warnings on timing screen/radio, 4th infringement black and white flag, 5th infringement will result in a DRIVE THROUGH PENALTY (followed by B/W warning then another Drive Through)

Per car not driver. If in last 10 minutes, automatically added as 30s time penalty in lieu of drive through (non appealable)









- Lead car will pull to PIT LANE






Missing car? **DO NOT** close the gap

RACE START GT4 GAP WILL BE 2 ROWS MINIMUM






Cars in two lines driving over the grid boxes Start Lights Red: when turned OFF= START OF RACE GT3 AND GT4

PENALTY = DRIVE THROUGH




SAFETY CAR





- "SC procedure"
- All marshal posts will display SC boards and waved yellow flags....LIGHT PANELS "SC"
- All cars, in single file, must catch up the group when safe to do so
- End of procedure: "SC in this lap"
- "SC lights off" after T8 all signalling removed
- Safety car exits via PIT LANE
- No overtaking prior to pass the FINISH line



LATE RACE INCIDENTS



- Incidents that occur towards the end of race:
 - If visibility is good
 - Track not blocked
 - May be covered with yellow flags
 - TEAM MANAGERS will be informed
 - You must slow down, maintain full control
 - ABSOLUTELY NO TRACK LIMITS
 - No overtaking before green flag

• Respect flags.

ON THE GRID

Podiums:

All cars required for the Podium will be directed to go to Parc Ferme in Scrutineering Bay, Pit Exit. Podium is in the Paddock, by Scrutineering Bay.

GT3 Overall 1st 2nd 3rd
GT3 Silver-Am 1st 2nd 3rd
GT4 Overall 1st 2nd 3rd
GT4 Pro-Am 1st 2nd 3rd

GT3 and GT4 <u>race winning co-drivers to go to Scrutineering</u> immediately at the end of the race for live ty interviews

All other podium finishing co-drivers to go to the Podium area driver pen, to start the podium as soon as possible.

ALL CARS ARE TO BE IN PARC FERME CONDITIONS – NO TEAM MEMBERS TO TOUCH THE CARS UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY AN OFFICIAL

Sunday Warm-up DONINGTON PARK BUS SAFARI

End of Warm up – CHEQUERED FLAG - RETURN TO PIT LANE

BUS will enter the track at T11 (Melbourne Hairpin)
Followed by the SAFETY CAR (at 60kph approx.)
Safety car procedure; ALL POINTS YELLOW and SC BOARDS/LIGHTS

ALL CARS ARE INVITED TO LINE UP IN THE FAST LANE.
WHEN BUS HAS PASSED AND PIT EXIT IS GREEN
PROCEED TO CATCH THE SAFETY CAR AT MAX 100kph

WHEN INDICATED – OVERTAKE THE BUS AND COMPLETE A LAP AT MAX 100kph and then REJOIN the Safety car train.

When indicated – pass again the SC and BUS and return to the pits – end of session.
