

# Official Track Map







## Radios





Race Control to Driver radio will be used this weekend



Radio Checks in the assembly area. Be Ready



When you hear your car number, give a clear thumbs



Used for SAFETY MATTERS only



We are sharing the channel with GB3 for this event Expect the channel to be used before and during GB3 sessions



# Procedure for Qualifying





Proceed to the Assembly area at least 20 mins before session start.



When you are released from the assembly area, that is the start of the session.



You do **not** need to go to the pit lane but you may if you wish.



#### Practice starts





Practice starts can only be carried out at the pit lane exit during qualifying only

Location: LEFT side just before the pit speed limit ends.

Stay far LEFT as shown

Do not block the lane

Take care when exiting



#### Pit Exit



Pay attention to the pit exit light

Take care exiting, watch for cars already on track





# Procedure for Racing



- Proceed to the Assembly Area when instructed
- Be Ready for radio checks in assembly
- When released, directly to the grid, lined up by marshals.
- Countdown of 1 Minute then 30 Seconds, shown from the gantry
- Foreen flag lap will start, full lap, steady pace
- ND practice starts, wheel spinning or weaving after Start of kerb Left Side T12

# Returning to the Grid





Make sure you are correctly positioned in the grid markings


Wheels must be WITHIN markings

Front wing may be outside of markings



#### Start Procedure





Once all cars are in position, 5 second board displayed

ALL red lights on

ALL red lights off signals the race start




# Control Flags

Control Flags on drivers LEFT at the control line

We have use of the info panel

Make sure you look EVERY lap in BOTH locations







# Smart Marshalling



Smart Marshalling is in operation for this event

Black & White flags will be given directly to cars. And not necessarily be repeated at the control line

Black & White flags will be displayed on the timing screens for team's info

The most dangerous flag prevails





#### Track Limits


Pay Particular Attention to

Pit Exit (Judge of Fact)
Turn 1 (Redgate)
Turn 4 (Old Hairpin)
Turn 7 (McLeans)
Turn 10 (Fogarty Esses RIGHT Side)

The contact patch of all wheels must have contact with the RED & WHITE Kerbs

Sensors & Cameras are positioned to report infringements



# End of All Sessions



After taking the Chequered Flag, SLOW DOWN SIGNIFICANTLY

At T9 Take the NATIONAL circuit

We need you to slow down to create a gap

Pay attention to the marshal on the RIGHT, you may be instructed to stop

When instructed proceed into the pit lane

All the way to the end of pit lane turning LEFT into parc ferme






# Flag Signals



Motorsport UK Regulation NCR Chapter 12, Appendix 8, Art 12

At venues where light panels are operational these light signals will take priority and may be supplemented with flags.





# Yellow Flags




You MUST respect Yellow Flags

Make sure you are in FULL CONTROL of your car in yellow flag zones

No Overtaking

Make it very clear that you have slowed down for yellows. This makes the judicial process much easier

Sector times, onboard video & data may be analysed during the judicial process

# Red Flags




SLOW DOWN progressively under red flags

Be prepared to stop

Absolutely NO weaving or tyre warming

Qualifying: Return to pit lane

Races: Go to the back of the grid, marshals will instruct you from there





# Safety Car Procedure



No overtaking after passing your 1<sup>st</sup> Safety Car boards & yellow flags

Reduce Speed



Catch the safety car quickly but safely

Roof lights ON = Follow exactly where the safety car goes




# Safety Car Procedure



Safety car will join the circuit at the Pit Exit



On a restart, lights off T10 exit





# Safety Car Procedure


CHAMPIONSHIP BRDC

After end of End of kerb Left Side T11

No Weaving

No sudden acceleration or braking





Safety Car will enter pit lane

# Safety Car Restart



No overtaking or overlapping until the Control Line





















# Rain Lights





DO NOT use the rain light for anything other than for rain or in an emergency situation



It should NOT be used at any other time
