Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

### **Brief Details:**

Car 35 made contact with Car 24 at MP2.0, causing Car 24 to spin and then continue. A lasting advantage was gained by Car 35. Having reviewed onboard footage from Cars 35 and 24, and having interviewed both drivers, it was deemed that the driver of Car 35 be served with a +5 Place Grid Penalty for their next race, as well as 3 penalty points on their Motorsport UK licence.

Accordingly, under NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Grid Place Penalty to be served at a future race, when that can be applied.  
Number of Licence Penalty Points: 3

Additional Comments: +5 grid place penalty at the driver's next race.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with the NCR.
