<b>Fact:</b>	Pit lane infringement
<b>Offence:</b>	Breach of Article 36.8 of the British GT Championship Sporting and Technical Regulations
<b>Decision:</b>	Fine 500 GBP
<b>Reason:</b>	Report was received from Pit Lane judge of fact. Team Entrant interviewed and freely admitted due communication and co-ordination failure car 86 engine was running whilst on jacks.
